## SI 7 THE COURSE

### Globe 40 Leg #5 – approx 4850 NM

1	Starting area - near Muelle Barón, Valparaiso Bay			
2	Cape Horn	To be left to port		
3a	Finish line - Farol do Recife (red/ white lighthouse)	To be left to port	08°03.274 S	034°51.912 W
3b	Finish line – Starboard lateral red/ white tower (6 seconds flashing red)	To be left to starboard	08°03.249 S	034°51.219 W

## SI 8 MARKS

The starting marks will be:

The committee boat and a yellow inflatable buoy.

## SI 9 PROHIBITED AREAS

Boats shall not sail in the prohibited areas as set out in official nautical documents, Traffic Separation Schemes (TSS), protected areas for swimming and around dive boats, as well as all areas forbidden to navigation as specified in Appendix 1 of the Leg #5 SSI.

It is the skippers' responsibility to familiarise themselves with the areas that are prohibited or regulated. Prohibited areas are considered as obstructions. RRS [Definitions Obstruction (c)]

## SI 10 THE START

SI 10.2 The starting area will be near Muelle Barón, Valparaiso Bay.

SI 10.3 The starting line shall be between an orange flag on the committee vessel at the starboard end of the line and yellow inflatable buoy at the port end of the line.

SI 10.6 Late starters

10.6.a) a boat that is unable to start within the time specified in SI 10.5.4 may be given permission to start by the Race Committee and Race Direction at least two hours after and a maximum of 48 hours after the starting signal of the race

**Taking into account Amendment N°2 of the GLOBE 40 2025-2026 SI dated 25 January 2026**

Race Direction/ the Organising Authority can authorise an additional delay beyond 48 hours for a late starter.

SI 10.6 b) The starting line is as follows:


Waypoint Valparaiso S – leave to port 33°01.780 S 071°35.500 W

Waypoint Valparaiso N – leave to starboard 33°00.610 S 071°35.500 W

## SI 11.1 THE FINISH

The finishing line will be a virtual line, calculated by YB, between Farol de Recife and the starboard lateral tower at the southern end of the breakwater.

The geographical coordinates of the finish line are specified in SI 7.



## SI 12 SAFETY – COMMUNICATIONS

12.1 The race channel will be VHF 72

Valparaiso Capuerto Radio – VHF 16

Recife port – VHF 16

## SI 14.4 ACCIDENTALLY BROKEN SEAL

For a broken engine seal: penalty of 96 minutes

For any other broken seal: penalty of 48 minutes

## SI 16. SCORING

SI 16.2 Intermediate rankings and positions are scheduled every 4 hours except for the start and finish phases, and published on the website.

## SI17. EQUIPMENT AND MEASUREMENT INSPECTIONS (DP/NP)

17.1.1 Equipment and measurement inspections will take place before the start.

17.1.4 There is no maximum limit for the quantity of embarked drinking water and drinkable liquid in the fixed tanks of the boat and/or in containers of not more than 10 litres.

17.6 A boat shall be fully compliant with all the rules of the event from 1700 on Tuesday 17th February 2026 until the boat is inspected once she has finished the leg.

## SI 20. SUPPORT TEAM VESSELS (DP/NP)

20.2 Accredited STV may enter the 200 metre area around the starting line reserved for competitors up until 15 minutes before the starting signal.

### **Delete 17.3.1**

#### **Replace with:**

*17.3.1 The engine seal of the forward gear is mandatory and shall be fitted according to the procedure defined in Appendix 6 « Auto-sealing procedure ». The engine seal shall not be broken or removed without authorisation.*

## **NOR Globe40 2025**

### **Appendix 2, paragraph 2.1 is changed as follows:**

*- A spinnaker or gennaker, sealed, usable after agreement from Race Direction and resulting in a penalty of 5 hours.*

*Boats are permitted to carry additional sails on board within the limit of 12 sails. These sails shall be sealed. The penalty for breaking the seal of one of these sails will be at the Jury's discretion.*
